

About This Program



High risk meds are identified as those which, when absent, may lead to significant therapeutic failure or in combination may increase the risk to the SM in a theater environment. Medications include those for diabetes, epilepsy, HIV, asthma, and coagulation disorders, as well as, psychotropic medications, such as, anti-depressants, anti-convulsants (mood stabilizers), stimulants (both C-II and non), anti-anxiety, anti-psychotic, and sleep agents.

Chronic meds may also be identified as high-risk but include those for BP, glaucoma, cholesterol control, etc.

Non-deployment meds include those drugs not available on the CENTCOM formulary and which may be obtained through the mail order (MOP) while in theater. The MOP is currently the refill method of choice for deploying SMs with a high degree of success with the program. While SRPs providers are encouraged to use medications available on the CENTCOM formulary, many time SMs are stabilized on particular drugs and should not be switched.

P-MART | Prescription Medication Analysis And Reporting Tool - About

P-MART | Prescription Medication Analysis And Reporting Tool

This program was developed to aid healthcare providers responsible for the medical care of deploying service men and women. The intent is to identify individuals who might require a more intensive medical review or to alert healthcare providers of medication needs not available in standard deployment packs.

MOD 12 are high risk medications are defined here as those medications, when not provided, have the potential for a significant therapeutic failure possibly resulting in a medical evacuation. Included are medications used in the treatment of diabetes, epilepsy, most psychiatric conditions, conception, HIV, asthma, malaria or tuberculosis prophylaxis, smoking cessation, prenatal care, and coagulation disorders. To include all medications on MOD12 PPG TAB A Section H, Medications.

Controlled substances are those medications categorized by the federal government as having a higher potential for abuse or addiction. The included drugs are designated as Schedule II - V according to their medical use, potential for abuse, and safety or dependence liability.

Chronic medications, often referred to as maintenance medications, are those drugs taken on a routine bases and when not provided, have the potential for therapeutic failure.

This database contains Privacy Act information and is subject to criminal, civil and/or administrative penalties to those who willfully misuse this information and violate a person's rights under the Privacy Act. This information was provided pursuant a request from the Senior Medical Officer of this deploying unit. Reasonable and necessary security should be in place to protect this data from unauthorized users.

Patient Medication Profile



The Patient Medication Profiles button located on the homepage allows providers to get a snapshot of a service member's (SM) complete drug profile (Rxs dispensed at the MTF, retail, and mail order) over the time period requested. Prescription information includes drug name, drug classification, quantity, date filled and day supply. If, after the individual profile review, the provider determines the SM needs further follow up, the provider can check the "Add to Surgeon's Recall Roster, a separate report is available to identify all individuals on the recall roster. If the alpha roster is broken down by individual units, the report can also filter per unit.
