## DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE SUICIDE EVENT REPORT



**DODSER standardizes suicide surveillance across the armed services to support the military's suicide prevention mission.**

DODSER tracks a variety of suicide-related risks and factors. Authorized users must document all suicide deaths, incidents identified as suicide attempts or other suicide-related behaviors, such as intentional self-harm and suicidal ideation, in DODSER.

DODSER receives annual updates and features a user-friendly layout that accommodates mobile, tablet, and desktop viewing. Enhanced security protects sensitive information while streamlining access.
