WARFIGHTER BRAIN HEALTH PROVIDER TOOLKIT

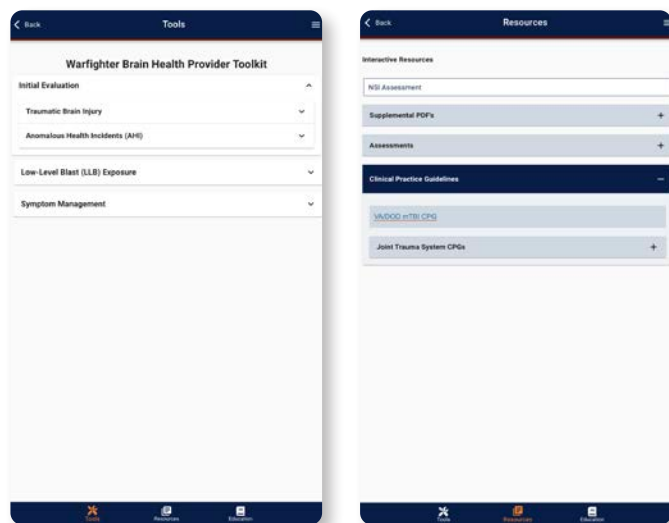


The Warfighter Brain Health Provider Toolkit offers easy access to many resources aimed at comprehensive management of patient brain health.

Developed at the request of the Traumatic Brain Injury Center of Excellence (TBICoE), the toolkit contains materials from the Department of Defense and the Department of Veterans Affairs. These include the Military Acute Concussion Evaluation 2, Progressive Return to Activity protocols, clinical recommendations, and fact sheets for both providers and patients.

The resources address brain health topics such as traumatic brain injury and low-level blast exposure. By providing these tools, the toolkit supports the Defense Health Agency's mission to modernize military health care and effectively manage warfighter brain health.
